2020 was also another record year for the **Independent Restaurant** sector across Greater China reflecting the increased focus by this category on creating outstanding wine offers for their customers and wanting to say so!

Finally, it is very encouraging to hear of the positive impact on respective businesses that success in the Awards is bringing to those deserving of recognition and reward for the outstanding levels they are achieving.

Its 37 wines by the glass, mostly under Coravin, include iconic wines from France, the Napa Valley, Italy, Spain and Germany. Arguably, it's the world's best list by the glass. The rest of the wine list is strongest in Burgundy and the Napa and yet circles the globe choosing outstanding wines from many great regions. There's the expected and the surprising: Clos Sainte Hune to Qupé; Araujo Estate to Tom Shobbrook. There's an interest in organic and biodynamic farming and the wines of China.
