Getting back on theme, Italian reds go big by way of Barolo and Barbaresco — pages and pages of them! — but there are gems to be found from very-hip-right-now regions like Etna and Sardinia, too. Depending on the exchange rate you're working with, you might even pick up an icon wine for a song, relatively speaking, with hard-to-find back vintages of Opus One, Rayas, Vega Sicilia and even Penfolds Grange on the go.

At Amber, it's like stepping into a wine museum: one can only quietly observe, in awe, the wonders of an amazingly well-puttogether collection of fine pieces of art, in this case, wine. The list opens with an extensive collection of Dom Perignon labels, followed by a diverse range of other renowned labels and new players from Champagne. It concludes with a concise list of the best sparkling wines from Europe and the UK. And this is only the first part of the list. While France is the primary focus, with a deep exploration of most of its regions across many vintages (verticals and back vintages are a common theme in this list), there is a plethora of other wine regions, from all over the world, explored and showcased with the utmost dedication. Additional information next to old wines, such as "exdomaine", "top shoulders", "soiled label", makes you feel that the money you're spending on this wine list is a good investment and that the sommeliers looking after such an impressive collection of wines are serious professionals. It's undoubtedly a hedonistic wine list, showing the deep knowledge and passion of the sommeliers. The fortified and sweet wine selections are impressive, too, as is the Cognac. But there is also an original aspect to it, including a natural wine section and an investigation of less explored wine regions such as Croatia.

What if you place all the attention on producers instead of regions and subregions? Aux Beaux Arts dare to try, shedding a light on those who have carried the beacon of quality in those wine regions, celebrated and loved over generations, and, I suspect, for another century to come. Think of every, or almost every, key player in France; you'll find it here. The collection of producers, their best cuvée, and a plethora of vintages are, quite frankly, jaw-dropping. There is also a lot of exploration across Italy, Australia and the Americas. Looking at the average vintage showcased, not only in classic regions like Bordeaux and Burgundy, but also in Portugal, with its red wine collection, one of the best that I've ever seen, I was expecting something from 100 years ago. I wasn't disappointed when perusing the port selection, and an almost 90-year-old Yquem didn't go unnoticed either. But to see a Seppeltsfield from 1888. Well, that brought tears to my eyes.

A wine tour of the world awaits at Avant. This cleverly presented wine list paves the way across the major wine producing countries with maps highlighting the regions covered in each category, a handy way to path your wine progress matched beautifully to the creative, "modern" cuisine served. Krug champagne starts the journey - not a bad introduction! - with a range of Champagnes back to 1990. The Champagne list looks to both the big houses and smaller growers, it's a policy employed throughout the list as some of the world's biggest wine stars are nicely balanced by a group of bright, artisanal producers making quality wines. Highlights are plenty starting with Burgundy, but do seek out the Spanish and German white wines and Italian and North American reds, while the Chinese wine selection is essential viewing. Natural and orange wines are listed and this is one list that takes its rosé seriously.
